WHAT DAYS/TIMES DOES THE FIXED ROUTE BUS OPERATE?

The bus will run an established route from 7am - 6:30pm, Mon - Fri and 8am - 1pm, Sat/Sun.

HOW MUCH DOES RIDING THE BUS COST?

There is a \$2 suggested contribution per ride to help supplement the cost of the public route; please contribute what you can. Each bus has a donation box.

HOW FREQUENTLY DOES THE BUS RUN?

The bus is currently slated to pick up at each location once every 30 minutes.

HOW WILL PEOPLE RECOGNIZE THE FIXED ROUTE BUS COMPARED TO OTHER GCT BUSES?

The fixed route bus will say *Sheridan Shuttle* over the front window and also has colored signs in various places on the bus.

HOW WERE STOPS SELECTED?

The route was designed to serve the greatest number of people in the Sheridan area as a “community initiative,” with consideration taken for densely populated apartment complexes and key services in the community.

WHO CAN RIDE THE BUS? IS THERE AN AGE LIMIT FOR KIDS?

The bus is available for all riders. Children must be 11 years old to ride alone. Younger children must be accompanied by an adult.

WHAT IF I HAVE MY PET WITH ME?

Only service dogs are allowed on the bus. People may schedule a door-to-door ride and bring their pet as long as it's in a carrier.

WHAT IF I HAVE MY BIKE, SKATEBOARD, SCOOTER, ETC. WITH ME? CAN THE BUS ACCOMMODATE WHEELCHAIRS OR WALKERS?

The bus is equipped with bike racks. Skateboards and foot scooters are allowed and may be carried onto the bus. No gas or battery-powered scooters will be allowed. The bus will be able to accommodate your wheelchair or walker.

WILL THERE BE ANY CHANGES TO THE DOOR-TO-DOOR SERVICE?

The existing Goose Creek Transit service will not change. You may still call the GCT office (675-7433) and schedule a ride for a future date.
